Mt. Blue Regional School District was notified today that **one (1)** person associated with our district has tested positive for COVID-19. Contact tracing is complete and **NO** close contacts were identified. Our schools continue to be cleaned per CDC guidelines. The number of cases and the impacted schools/locations are included below.

As we return from April vacation, we want to ensure that our families who have traveled have the most up-to-date information pulled from a [Priority Notice](#) sent by the MDOE.

- Maine currently requires people traveling to states outside of New England to test or quarantine. Details of testing, quarantine timelines, and other special considerations can be found here, in the Governor's [Travel Guidance for Schools](#).

- Students and staff who are fully vaccinated and two weeks past their last dose do not need to quarantine if they are considered a close contact.
