Nina M. Bitterauf Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 1999 by the family and friends of Nina Bitterauf following her death from an automobile accident that occurred on the way home from a day of skiing at Sugarloaf Mountain. At the time of her death, Nina was a senior honor student at the University of Vermont where she majored in English and was a member of the UVM crew team. She was looking forward to graduate school and had just received a summer internship as an assistant editor for Bon Appetit Magazine in Burlington Vermont.

Nina graduated from Mt. Blue High School in 1995 where she made outstanding contributions both academically and athletically. She was a member of the National Honor Society, participated in soccer and track, and was the captain of the Mt. Blue Cross Country Ski Team. Having grown up in Farmington, Nina always loved to come home and visit with her friends, hike the mountains of Weld, ski the cross country trails at Titcomb and downhill trails at Sugarloaf.

It is the hope of the selection committee that Nina's memory will live on through this scholarship and that her legacy will inspire students to embrace their future with the same determination, commitment, and enthusiasm that made Nina's short life full of great possibilities and memorable experiences.



APPLICATION GUIDLINES

To qualify for this scholarship, a student must be a Mt. Blue High school senior in good standing who is going on to a two or four year college or technical school.

Interested students are requested to submit the following:

- A completed application form
- A copy of recent transcript
- A letter of recommendation from two teachers
- A letter from coach or community leader
- A brief essay describing your future goals and what high school experience influenced you and why.

This scholarship is a one-time cash award of \$1000.00 per recipient payable directly to the college or university after the completion of the spring semester of the freshman year. Funds must be applied toward tuition, room, and/or board. If the recipient fails courses and/or withdraws from college during the year, scholarship funds will not be awarded and will be applied to future scholarship awards.
