College Scholarships for the Academic Year 2022-2023

#### About the Scholarship

The Stephen Phillips Memorial Scholarship Fund offers renewable, four-year scholarships to students with financial need who display academic achievement, a commitment to serving others (in school, the community or at home), a consistent history of part-time work, grit and passion for overcoming obstacles and/or achieving future goals, and leadership qualities.

- ✓ Applicants may attend college anywhere in the United States but must be from New England.
- ✓ Awards are limited to students seeking their first bachelor's degree at a four-year college. They may be high school seniors or prospective or current college students who will be attending college full time in 2022-2023.
- ✓ Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a scale of 4.0 to be considered.
- ✓ Students should be involved with community service and have a history of part-time employment.
- Applicants must have financial need. It is our intent to award students with Expected Family Contributions (EFC) of about \$10,000 or less, although families with special, extenuating financial situations should call or email to see if they should apply. Before beginning the application, use the financial calculator on the Phillips website to be sure that you qualify financially. Your financial need considers the scholarships and grants that your college gives you, so you need to have that information in order to calculate your need.
- √ 93% of newly awarded students in 2021 had family AGIs of less than \$80,000 and 83% had EFCs below \$6,000.
- ✓ Applicants must either be United States citizens or noncitizens with a current lawful presence and work authorization in the U.S.

#### How to Apply

Visit www.phillips-scholarship.org for more information about applying for the scholarship and to access the scholarship application. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED USING THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM. Mailed applications will not be considered.

Begin your online application early enough to be thorough in your responses and to give recommenders time to respond to your recommendation requests. The majority of applicants report spending between 4 and 10 hours to complete the application.

To complete your application, you will need to upload

- ✓ One formal essay, a few short responses, and a resume (optional)
- ✓ Financial Aid Award information from the college or university that you plan to attend
- ✓ Your FAFSA Student Aid Report
- ✓ The names and contact details of at least two recommenders.

Regular Deadline - 12 noon, May 2, 2022. Applicants will be notified of decisions in late June.

**Early Response Deadline – 12 noon April 4, 2022.** Available only to high school students who have the financial aid information from the college they prefer to attend. The first 400 students to submit an application before April 4<sup>th</sup> will receive a decision before the common reply date of May 1st.

2021 Student W-2 Form(s) and 2020 Parent Tax Forms may be requested later in the process.
