



The Alden Mitchell Scholarship

Alden was a long time Legionnaire of this Post, a WWII Army Veteran, a long-time teacher in the Farmington School system, and later Mt. Blue High School.

This scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating High School Senior that is planning to further their education or training. This does not have to be a four-year college. The recipient of this scholarship must have a living parent or grandparent that is a member of an American Legion Post (Legionnaire) or have a living parent or grandparent that has served in the armed forces (Veteran). You may qualify under a deceased parent or grandparent if they were an active member of the Legion at the time of their death.

This scholarship, in the amount of \$300.00, will be awarded to the recipient after they have successfully completed their first semester in a school of higher learning or training.

In the event that the scholarship cannot be used in the academic year immediately following the recipient's graduation from high school they will need to reapply for the scholarship.
