- Friday May 14, 2 pm: Speeches and Music for Illumination and Graduation: Final copies & lyrics due to Mrs. Woodsum in B311.
- Tuesday, June 1st: Cap & Gown Purchase and Photo. Students pay \$40 in CASH this day for their caps and gowns. Professional photos will be taken of each senior, individually, wearing their cap & gown. Information will be online for ordering photos. (You ordered your cap & gown in September.)
- Wednesday, June 2nd: Collection of ALL RSU 9 materials including laptops, chargers and case, Library and class books, cafeteria bills, uniforms, music, etc. begins today. Everything must be passed in and payments made BEFORE tickets are passed out.
- Sunday, June 6: MANDATORY Illumination Ceremony in MBC Bijorn Auditorium. Come join us for a chance to say goodbye to our International Students and celebrate some of our memories, music, and friends. Undecorated caps and gowns must be worn. Parents will want to attend. The event will last about an hour. This event is dependent on the Covid-19 social gathering guidelines in place for June
- Monday, June 7: FTC Recognition Night. All FTC students will attend this ceremony recognizing participation in Tech programs. Parents will want to attend. This event will be about 1-1/2 hours in length. May be held outside or over Zoom.
- Monday and Tuesday, June 7 and 8: Final exams during the regular school day, for seniors who need to take them. No senior classes are held.
- Tuesday, June 8: MANDATORY Awards Night. ALL seniors will attend this ceremony during which scholarships are awarded and those entering the military are honored. Parents may attend with you. Seating is at tables of 10. Dress is school appropriate, no hats. You may bring food to eat. This ceremony lasts about 2 hours. May be held outside or over Zoom.
- Wednesday, June 9: All of this day's events are dependent on the Covid-19 social gathering guidelines in place for June.
- MANDATORY Marching Practice. All seniors will attend this session.
- MANDATORY Senior Class Photo. All seniors will sit in the bleachers for a professional class group photo.
- MANDATORY Senior Assembly. All students will attend this senior-class designed celebration wearing your undecorated cap and gowns.
- MANDATORY Graduate Stroll at all other schools. All seniors, in cap & gown, will board busses to visit the elementary and middle schools. Graduates will walk through the halls visiting and spreading good cheer to the student body and staff. Lunch will be provided. Pick up tickets at the end of the day.
- MANDATORY for performers: Speech practice and Music practice.
